**INCOME-TAX**

**S.O.2394(E).**- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 295 of the Income-tax Act, 1961 (43 of 1961), the Central Board of Direct Taxes hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Income-tax Rules, 1962, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Income-tax (**7th Amendment**) Rules, 2011.
- (2) They shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November, 2011.

2. In the Income-tax Rules, 1962,-

(A) in rule 114, -

(a) in sub-rule (1), after the words, figures and letter "Form 49A", the words, figures and letters, " or 49AA , as the case may be" shall be inserted;

(b) in sub-rule (3),-

(i) for the words "accounting year" wherever they occur, the words "financial year" shall be substituted;

(ii) after item (iii), the following item shall be inserted, namely:-

" (iv) in the case of a person who is entitled to receive any sum or income or amount , on which tax is deductible under Chapter XVIIB in any financial year, before the end of such financial year.";

(c) in sub-rule (4), for the words “Table below shall be accompanied by documents mentioned in Column 3” the words “ Table below shall be filed in Forms mentioned in Column 3 and shall be accompanied by the documents mentioned in Column 4” shall be inserted ;

(d)For the Table, the following Table shall be substituted, namely : -

(b) Each box, wherever provided, should contain only one character (alphabet /number / punctuation sign) leaving a blank box after each word.

(c) 'Individual' applicants should affix two recent colour photographs (size 3.5 cm x 2.5 cm) in the space provided on the form. The photographs should not be stapled or clipped to the form. The clarity of image on PAN card will depend on the quality and clarity of photograph affixed on the form.

(d) Signature / Left hand thumb impression should be provided across the photo affixed on the left side of the form.

(e) Signature /Left hand thumb impression should be within the box provided on the right side of the form. The signature should not be on the photograph affixed on right side of the form. If there is any mark on this photograph such that it hinders the clear visibility of the face of the applicant, the application will not be accepted.

(f) Thumb impression, if used, should be attested by a Magistrate or a Notary Public or a Gazetted Officer under official seal and stamp.

(g) AO code (Area Code, AO Type, Range Code and AO Number) must be filled up by the applicant. These details can be obtained from the Income Tax Office or TIN Facilitation Centre (TIN-FC) may assist in doing so.
